THE CHALLENGE PROGRAM

The Destination Imagination Challenge Program is a project-based system of learning with focuses on STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics), the arts, social entrepreneurship and early learning. Through solving a DI Challenge, participants gain knowledge and experience in creative and critical thinking, project management, team building, conflict resolution, perseverance, and a completion mindset—the very skills need to thrive in any chosen career.

Students work together in teams to plan, design and develop a solution to a DI Challenge. Teams must solve the Challenge on their own without interference from Team Managers, parents or other individuals who are not on their team.

Teams have the opportunity to present their solutions at a Regional Tournament. Each team solution is evaluated and scored on a variety of elements, including originality, workmanship, presentation and teamwork. Teams with the highest scores at their Regional Tournament advance to their Affiliate (state/country) Tournament. The top-tiered teams from the Affiliate Tournaments advance to Global Finals—the world's largest celebration of student creativity.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The Team Registration allows the purchaser to put together one team of two to seven participants. Team Registrations do not need to be affiliated with a school or organization. There are no restrictions on how a team is assembled or selected.

The Team Registration entitles a given team to participate in a Team Challenge at any Level (i.e., Elementary, Middle, etc.) defined within the Destination Imagination program structure.

Make sure that your team is the only team competing under your assigned Team Number. Each team must have a distinct Team Number.

Some locations have laws regarding children who attend private schools and participate in public school activities. Follow the laws of your state, province, school district or organization before Destination Imagination rules.

UNIVERSITY LEVEL: Full-time, post-secondary students enrolled in college, university, trade, or technical school or military college-bound. High school seniors who are taking accredited courses offered by a college or university that will qualify for course credit when entering higher education.

Most Regional and Affiliate Tournaments occur between February and April. If you qualify at the Affiliate level, you advance to Global Finals.
