The following are the age/grade requirements for 2017-18 Destination Imagination teams.

EARLY LEARNING: Preschool-2nd Grade

ELEMENTARY LEVEL (EL): Kindergarten-5th Grade or no student born before June 15, 2006

MIDDLE LEVEL (ML): 6th-8th Grade or no student born before June 15, 2003

SECONDARY LEVEL (SL): 9th-12th Grade or no student born before June 15, 1999

COLLEGE & UNIVERSITY LEVEL: Full-time, post-secondary students enrolled in college, university, trade, or technical school or in the military. College-bound high school seniors who are taking accredited courses offered by a college or university that will qualify for course credit when entering higher education.

IMPORTANT: The Team Number allows the purchaser to put together one team of two to seven participants. Team Numbers do not need to be affiliated with a school or organization. There are no restrictions on how a team is assembled or selected. Each team must have a distinct Team Number. Some locations have laws regarding children who attend private schools and participate in public school activities. Follow the laws of your state, province, school district or organization before Destination Imagination rules.
