Focus: Innovation and design process, technical design and construction, teamwork.

Challenge

Your task is to create a work of wall art using only the materials below and then photograph the artwork.

Part One: Use the materials to create a work of wall art. Give your artwork a title and sign it with your name and the date before hanging it on a wall. You should also take photographs of your artwork. Plan ways you can share your work of art and the photos of your work of art with others.

Part Two: Share your artwork (either in-person or virtually) by using the photos of your artwork on cards or mini-posters. Create a list of people who would enjoy receiving your cards or mini-posters. Share with people who may not be friends or family.

- 1 Large Piece of Paper or Poster Board
- 20 Paper Clips in Different Sizes and Shapes
