Still not satisfied, the team shifted the materials to create an even better waterproof seal, finally directing the water for maximum score. Incredible risk-taking and overall creative application of the materials earned an Instant Challenge DaVinci Award for the Tool Sargeants from Huron Destination Imagination.
