A scavenger hunt is an activity where someone tries to find items on a list in a short amount of time. Looking for items in a scavenger hunt can be lots of fun, but what if instead of finding the items you had to make the items?

Now it's your turn to create your own scavenger hunt items.



Challenge

Your task is to create 5 items that are found on a list for a scavenger hunt.

The Scene: You have been given a list of items for a scavenger hunt. Your list includes:

- Something found in the garden
- A toy a kitten would like
- A utensil to eat with
- Something valuable
- Anything brightly colored
- Something with a top and a bottom
- A growing object

Look at the list and decide on 5 items from the list you will create. You should use only the materials below to build those 5 items.



Materials

□ 1 Piece of Foil	5 Craft Sticks	□ 3 Mailing Labels
□ 7 Chenille Sticks (Pipe Cleaners)	5 Rubber Bands	🗆 1 Garbage Bag
□ 2 Index Cards	□ 5 Markers	2 Paper Cups

□ 1 Pair of Scissors

The scissors and markers may not be damaged and may not be part of the 5 items.

- B. Which item is the most creative? What makes it the most creative?
- C. What materials were the easiest to use? What other materials did you wish you had to use?
