



An Instant Challenge is a great Destination Imagination way to develop 21st Century skills in the 4 Cs: creativity, communication, collaboration, and critical thinking. Join your child in solving this challenge or encourage a group of friends or siblings to tackle it!

Focus: Innovation, logical reasoning, sequencing, videography.

You have been part of a team before. A team is two or more people coming together to make something happen. Teams of people play sports. Other teams of people work on projects together. Even doctors work in teams to heal the sick. Sometimes these teams need help. The teams need a tutorial. A tutorial is teaching someone how to do something. There are all sorts of online videos that teach people how to do things.

Now it's your turn to create your own tutorial.

Imagine that you need to create a tutorial for a team to teach them to do something. Your tutorial can be for any type of team you choose, real or imaginary.



Challenge

Your task is to create a video tutorial in which you teach a team how to do something in 3 easy steps.

Part One: Who is the team? Select the team you would like to teach how to do something. The team can be real or imaginary. What will you teach the team? Decide how to creatively teach the task you have chosen in 3 easy steps. Using an iPad, phone, or camera, record a video showing your 3 easy steps. Ask friends and family members to be part of your video!

Part Two: Share your video with family and friends and ask them what they learned how to do by following your 3 easy steps.



Materials

Any materials around the house that would help to create the video. A tablet, cell phone, or camera that records video. (If you don't have a recording device, create a set of 3 drawings showing the 3 easy steps.)
